Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) placements continue to be offered for students enrolled in a related VET Certificate only, including Cert III Allied Health Assistance or Health Assistance Services. Both Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) and Work Experience opportunities have very limited places available in 2026. BNLLEN highly recommends students continue contacting other potential host employers for a student placement.
