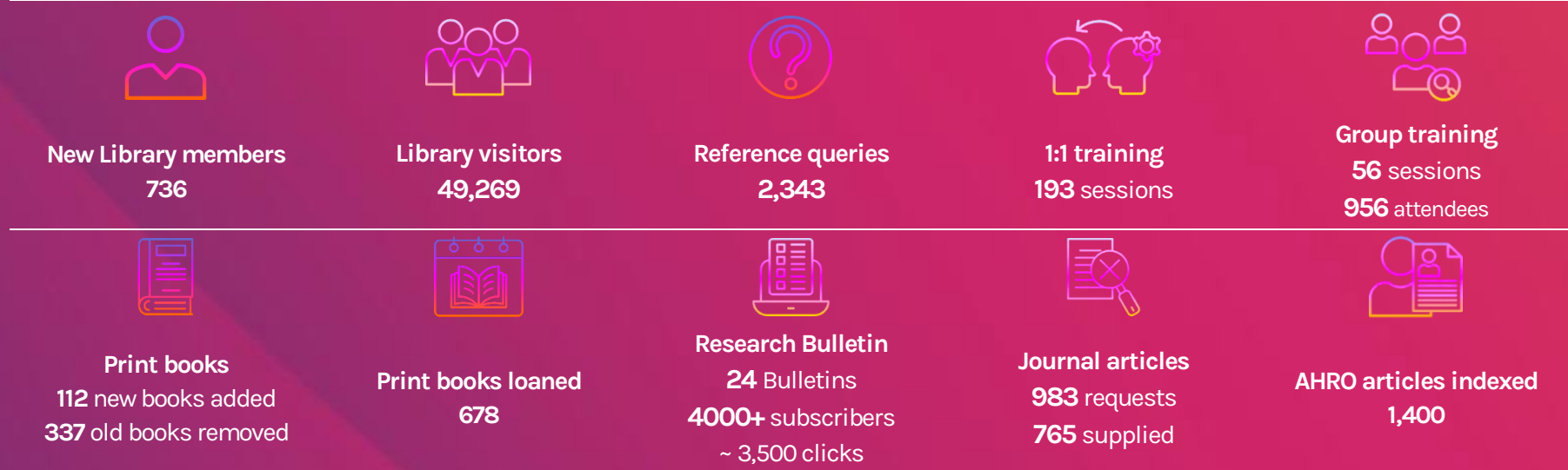


Austin Health Sciences Library – 2023
