
Going to the Ambulatory Care Centre (ACC) for a Procedure

Social Script




This is the main way to enter the hospital.

You will go through this entry to get to the lifts to the hospital.






You can follow signs to the orange lift area.

If you are lost or need help you can use the phone near the blue sign. They are near the orange lift or on level 1.








This is the Ambulatory
