

How to get to the Medical & Cognitive Research Unit (MCRU)

Heidelberg Repatriation Hospital

Located in Ivanhoe, a 2 minute drive from Austin Health's main campus in Heidelberg.

The campus is bound by four streets:

- North: Bell street
- East: Edwin street
- South: Banksia street
- West: Waterdale road

There are many buildings located on this campus.

The Medical and Cognitive Research Unit is located in the Centaur Wing.




Before Your Appointment

- A Research Nurse will call you the day before your appointment to discuss any help you might need.
- You will also be asked to bring all your current medications with you.



Getting to MCRU by Taxi

- If catching a taxi, ask the driver to enter Heidelberg Repatriation Hospital through **Gate 10**.
- Get out of the taxi at the Main Entrance of **Centaur Wing**.




Getting to MCRU by Car

If you are driving, you can enter the Hospital grounds via **Gate 9** off Waterdale Road or **Gate 10** off Banksia St.

You can park your car anywhere there are 3P signs. Suggestions are:


- “Outpatients carpark” (marked in purple)
- “Banksia Central carpark” (marked in green) or
- “Ashgrove carpark” (marked in blue).

If your appointment takes longer than 3 hours, you will have time to move your car.



Getting to MCRU by Car

- Once you have parked your car, follow the directions on the map to get to Centaur Wing.
- There are signs on the buildings to direct you.



Getting to MCRU: Inside Centaur Wing



- When you are inside the Centaur Wing, enter the lift and press the button for **Level 3**.
- If the lifts are not working, you can use the stairs



Getting to MCRU: Inside Centaur Wing

- You will step out of the lift at **Level 3**.
- The foyer has green walls.



Getting to MCRU: On level 3



- Enter through the sliding doors that say "Medical & Cognitive Research Unit (MCRU)".



Inside MCRU: Reception

- There will be someone at the reception desk to greet you.
- If reception is vacant, please ring the bell and a staff member will attend to you promptly



Inside MCRU: Reception

- There is an accessible toilet in the waiting area.
- You can ask a staff member to show you where it is.



Inside MCRU: Reception



- Sit down in the reception area. There might be other people waiting there too.
- The Research Nurse will come and greet you.



Inside MCRU: Meeting the Research Nurse

- The Research Nurse will explain to you what will happen during your appointment.



Inside MCRU: Meeting the Doctor



- You will be introduced to one of the Doctors who will invite you into their office and talk to you about the Clinical Trial.
- There will be plenty of time to ask all your questions.



Inside MCRU: Signing the Consent Forms

- If you decide to participate in the Clinical Trial, you will be given a consent form to sign.
- Your Study Partner will also sign a consent form.



Inside MCRU: Meeting the Psychologist

- You might be introduced to a Psychologist who will ask you some questions about your memory.



Inside MCRU: Tests You May Have

- You might be requested to have your blood taken.
- You might be requested to have an ECG.



Inside MCRU: Refreshments



- You will be offered some lunch and a drink of tea or coffee or water.



After Your Appointment



- You will be given a "Welcome Pack" to take home with you.
- It will have a copy of the forms that you signed.
- It will also have some useful information for you to read at home.



After Your Appointment

- When you have finished your appointment, the Research Nurse will say goodbye and show you the way out.



After Your Appointment



- If you drove, we will give you a ticket that will open the boom gate to exit the carpark.
- If you need to catch a taxi home, we will show you where the call button is.
