ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Transition to Specialty Practice Program: Cardiac stream, is designed to introduce and inspire nurses to explore the cardiac and thoracic specialty. In conjunction with experiential learning, the program comprises study days, clinical support and education, and an opportunity to experience Interventional Cardiology on 5North. Concepts explored will include advanced patient assessment, cardiac monitoring, and electrocardiography, deteriorating patient and Intro to ALS. Structured hurdles will support the theoretical concepts necessary to deliver safe patient outcome.

- Participants will develop and demonstrate the capacity to think critically and develop specific nursing skills in the cardiothoracic clinical care environment.
- Participants will demonstrate an alignment of clinical and theoretical knowledge to plan and implement excellence in evidence-based care.
